NOTICE OF RACE
12th SA Youth Championship
Somerton Yacht Club - 20th February 2011

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The regatta will be conducted by the Somerton Yacht Club and the South Australian Heron Sailing Association Inc on behalf of the South Australian Heron Association Inc.

2. RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the class rules and by laws of the National Heron Sailing Association Inc and South Australian Heron Sailing Association Inc except as these are changed by the sailing instructions and the Notice of Race. The Special Regulations of Yachting Australia – Part 2 (off the beach boats) shall apply to all entrants.

3. CATEGORIES

There will be two categories for entrants. Boats can only be entered in one category:

- 3.1 Youth skipper/Youth crew combination
- 3.2 Youth skipper/Adult crew

4. ELIGIBILITY

- 4.1 All boats entering shall have a **current "A"** class measurement certificate.
- 4.2 The Helmsperson for each yacht shall be **under the age of 20 years as at 31st December 2010.**
- 4.3 The crew of boats entered in the youth/youth category shall be **under the age of 20 years as at 31st December 2010.**
- 4.4 There shall be no change of Helmsperson of a yacht during the regatta. A replacement helmsperson shall constitute a new entry, which will be scored as DNS for all previous races in the regatta.
- 4.5 The helmsperson for each yacht shall be a member of a yacht or sailing club affiliated with Yachting South Australia.

5. ENTRIES

- 5.1 The entry form attached shall be lodged/received by **18 February 2011** to:
S.A. Heron Sailing Association Inc., c/- 1 Day Ave, Daw Park SA 5041
- 5.2 There is **no** entry fee for the regatta.

6. REGISTRATION

The helmsperson shall exhibit the following items at registration between 0815 and 0915 hrs, on 20 February 2011 at the Somerton Yacht Club:

- 6.1 Measurement certificate verifying eligibility of the entered boat.
- 6.2 Sails that have been measured and bear the initials of the Measurer and the date of measurement. Only one jib and one mainsail shall be used by any yacht during the series, except that in the event of damage to an accepted sail when the Race Officer may authorize a substitute.
- 6.3 Helmspersons are asked to ensure that all sails are measured and initialled by an official measurer of the NHSAA before the series. No provision will be made for sail or boat measuring at the Somerton Yacht Club.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at Registration from the regatta office located in the Somerton Yacht Club.

9. COURSES

Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

10. SCORING

- 10.1** The Low Point Scoring system as defined in appendix "A" – Scoring (A4 - Lowpoint) will apply except that Rule A4.2 is changed to provide that a boat, which starts the race but does not finish shall score points equal to one more than the number of boats that ranked as starters in that race.
- 10.2** The series will consist of three (3) races.
- 10.3** Two (2) races are required to constitute a series.
- 10.4** When two (2) or more races have been completed a boat series score shall consist of her total race scores (i.e. there will be no discards).
- 10.5** A boat's place in each heat will be recorded as the place over the line in the category of entry.

11. PRIZES

- 11.1** Prizes will be awarded to skippers and crews that finish in the following places:

Youth Helmsperson and Youth Crew Combination

First placing overall
Second placing overall
Third placing overall

Youth Helmsperson and Adult Crew Combination

First placing overall
Second placing overall
Third placing overall

- 11.2** Prizes will be presented at the Annual General Meeting of the SA Heron Sailing Association or at any other appropriate Presentation night if applicable.
